STIPULATION OF SHUTTLE EXPRESS, INC., AND SEATAC SHUTTLE, LLC

Shuttle Express, Inc., d/b/a Shuttle Express ("Shuttle Express") and SeaTac

Shuttle ("SeaTac") stipulate to the following:

SeaTac agrees to narrow and clarify the authority it seeks by adding the following underlined language to its request and deleting the strikethrough language:

PASSENGER SERVICE by reservation only:

BETWEEN: Oak Harbor and the SeaTac International Airport via SR20 and, SR525 to, the Clinton-Mukilteo Ferry, via SR525, SR526, Interstate 5, direct to SeaTac. Door to door service in conjunction with the above route with pickup points within 1 mile of on SR20 and SR525, originating on Whidbey Island and terminating at SeaTac. Closed door service between Clinton and SeaTac.

ALTERNATE ROUTE: In the event that the Clinton-Mukilteo Ferry service is not available or there are no other reservations for passengers on the above named route south of Oak Harbor the company may for any individual trip elect to utilize the following alternate route: SR525, SR20, Interstate 5 via Burlington, with closed door service between Oak Harbor and SeaTac.

1 The holder of this certificate may operate a two wheeled trailer having a gross
2 licensed weight of not exceeding 2,000 pounds when such trailer is used to carry
3 baggage or express and is towed by a vehicle in which passengers are being
4 transported.

5 Shuttle Express stipulates that it has no objection to SeaTac's application, so long
6 as the Commission adopts SeaTac's requested authority with the amendments shown above.
7 Shuttle Express will remain a party to this proceeding to ensure that the Commission adopts the
8 authority as stated above or with amendments that are acceptable to Shuttle Express. If the
9 Commission rejects the above-stated amendment, Shuttle Express will request a continuance of
10 the hearing so that it can prepare a case and present witnesses.
