The purpose of this filing is to increase rates to recover increased electric and gas revenue requirements of \$81.6 million and \$47.2 million respectively, on an annual basis, or 6.5% and 6.29%. The impact of the filing is described in greater detail in the Summary Document, three copies of which are filed herewith as **Addendum E**. Pursuant to WAC 480-07-510(5), we are also mailing copies of the Summary Document to the persons listed on the Certificate of Service attached to this letter. A copy of the cover letter and certificate of service for the Summary Document are also provided in Addendum E.

Also being provided with this filing are 12 copies of the Company's prefiled direct testimony and exhibits supporting this rate filing. These materials will be offered into the record at the appropriate time and should not be considered evidence until so entered.

We also provide three copies of supporting work papers and the Company's most recent two annual reports to shareholders; subsequent quarterly reports to shareholders; the most recent FERC Forms 1, 2 and 2A; and for the most recent two years, the Company's Forms 10K and 10Q, prospectuses for issuances of securities and quarterly reports to stockholders. In compliance with the new WAC 480-07-510(3)(f), we have also provided three copies of a Report of Affiliated Interest Transactions for the test year.

We have enclosed CD ROMs with electronic copies of these materials where available. Please note that some of Mr. Jeffrey Dubin's workpapers are only available electronically.

The Company requests that the documents contained in the envelopes identified with the cover page marked "CONFIDENTIAL PER WAC 480-07-160," as well as the files marked "confidential" on the versions of the disks and CD ROMs containing confidential materials be treated as confidential under the provisions of WAC 480-07-160 as they each contain sensitive commercial information. As required by WAC 480-07-160(3), the Company identifies itself, its customers, and its shareholders as the entities that might be directly affected by disclosure of the confidential information. In accordance with WAC 480-07-160(3)(b), the documents noted above are marked "CONFIDENTIAL PER WAC 480-07-160". In accordance with WAC 480-07-160(3)(c) the Company has enclosed redacted versions of the documents containing confidential information in its filing, and has placed unredacted versions of the documents containing confidential information in separate envelopes with corresponding "CONFIDENTIAL PER WAC 480-07-160" labels on the envelopes. In accordance with WAC 480-07-160(3)(c) each page of the unredacted version containing confidential information has been printed on yellow paper and each page containing highly confidential information has been printed on light blue paper.

CD ROMs containing confidential materials have also been appropriately identified. Please note that for the Commission's convenience, each CD ROM contains a complete set of the filing, except that the "Redacted" CD ROM does not contain any confidential or highly confidential files, the "Confidential" CD ROM contains all but the highly confidential files, and the "Highly Confidential" CD ROM contains all of the files. The file names for each document identify whether the document is "confidential" or "highly confidential".

The tariff sheets described herein reflect issue dates of April 5, 2004 and effective dates of May 6, 2004. The Company expects that the Commission will issue an order suspending these proposed changes for investigation and that a hearing to take testimony from the public will be scheduled at the prehearing conference. Therefore, the Company will provide notice to the public pursuant to WAC 480-100-197 and 480-90-197.
