

IMPORTANT NOTICE
January 27, 2006

Canterwood Water Company was required by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (WUTC) to re-evaluate the rates that went into effect May 27, 2004. Canterwood Water Company is not proposing to change your current monthly water rate, however this filing may result in increased revenue to the company. If approved by the WUTC, this filing will go into effect on March 1, 2006.

On May 27, 2004, the company instituted a new rate structure, designed to promote water conservation and efficiency. Surplus revenues generated by the new rate structure were placed into a capital improvement fund to be used for capacity related projects due to high customer water use. This filing proposes that the company be allowed to use future revenue for increased operating expenses. Canterwood will also continue to make system improvements necessary to meet maximum day and peak hourly demands from high customer water use.

Your current rates are as follows:
