RE: Rulemaking to Consider Damage Reporting Requirements for Gas Pipeline Companies in WAC 480-93, Docket PG-120345

TO ALL INTERESTED PERSONS:

This letter is to inform you of the progress made in this rulemaking docket concerning possible adoption of proposed revisions to WAC 480-93-200 Reporting requirements. This letter also provides notice of an opportunity to file written comments on the proposed rule amendments and to participate in the formal rule adoption hearing scheduled for 9:30 a.m. on Wednesday, December 19, 2012.

On October 24, 2012, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) filed with the Code Reviser a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (CR-102) in this docket regarding requirements for gas pipeline operators to report data and provide documentation to the Commission of damage to pipeline facilities in violation of Chapter 19.122 RCW. The Commission developed the proposed rule revisions with the benefit of stakeholder participation at the May 10, 2012, workshop and from written comments received on May 25 and August 17, 2012, which are available in this docket on the Commission's website <http://www.utc.wa.gov/120345>.

The CR-102 begins the final part of the rulemaking process, which includes a written comment period, a public adoption hearing, and a decision by the Commission.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE of your opportunity to submit written comments on the proposed rule to the Commission by filing with the Commission Executive Director and Secretary either by electronic transmission as described below, or by physical delivery to 1300 S. Evergreen Park Drive S.W., P.O. Box 47250, Olympia, Washington, 98504-7250, no later than 5:00 p.m., Monday, November 26, 2012. The proposed rule, as filed with the Code Reviser, is available for inspection on the Commission's web site at <http://www.utc.wa.gov/120345>. Additionally, upon request, the Commission will send you a paper copy if needed.

Electronic copies: The Commission asks that you provide your comments in electronic format to enhance public access, for ease of providing comments, to reduce the need for paper copies, and to facilitate quotations from the comments.
