Dear Staff:

Boomerang Wireless, LLC d/b/a enTouch Wireless (Boomerang Wireless) was designated as an eligible telecommunications carrier on December 12, 2013 in Docket No. UT-121610. Docket No. UT-121610 requires Boomerang Wireless to provide information quarterly to the Commission on the number that it enrolls each month. Boomerang is also required to report the number of deactivated Lifeline customers each month by service plan and the reasons for deactivation (e.g., no usage for 60 consecutive days, annual verification unsuccessful, or voluntary exit).

Pursuant to this requirement Boomerang Wireless, LLC submits this letter to notify the Commission that while Boomerang intends to comply with the filing requirement, the company does not yet have the data available for the quarter ending June 30, 2014. The data is being developed into the required categories will be filed with this Commission as quickly as it becomes available in order to maintain compliance with this filing obligation. The company expects to have this data filed no later than August 15, 2014.
