Order of Default Judgment, Superior Court for Kitsap County No. 15-2-00313-7**

Dear Mr. Clasablanca:

As you are aware, on May 8, 2015, a Default Judgment was entered against you and Right Choice Movers in the Superior Court for Kitsap County. The Default Judgment ordered you to comply with the Commission's Order 02, dated October 8, 2013, in Commission Docket TV-131599, by ceasing and desisting from engaging in business as a household goods carrier without first obtaining a permit from the Commission, as required under RCW 81.80.075. The Default Judgment also directed you to pay a civil penalty, including attorneys' fees, in the amount of \$20,520.

The Commission has no record to date that the Company has made any payments in compliance with the court's Default Judgment. Accordingly, the Commission sent you a Final Notice dated June 26, 2015, indicating that the balance of \$20,520 was due.

**This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection.** You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$20,520 balance.
