NOTICE WAIVING PENALTY

RE: *Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Adam's Moving and Delivery Service, LLC*, Docket TV-143601

TO ALL PARTIES:

On March 27, 2015, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 01, Initial Order Imposing and Suspending Penalties, In Part (Order 01) in the above-referenced case. Order 01 assessed a penalty of \$5,700 against Adam's Moving and Delivery Service, LLC (Adam's Moving) for 579 violations of Washington Administrative Code (WAC) 480-15 and Tariff 15-C, a \$2,850 portion of which was suspended for a period of two years conditioned on Adam's Moving paying the remaining \$2,850 portion promptly and not incurring any repeat violations during the two-year suspension period.

On April 23, 2015, Commission financial services filed a statement of account in this docket noting that the \$2,850 unsuspended portion of the penalty was paid.

On October 16, 2017, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that Staff had conducted a follow up investigation of Adam's Moving's documents for the period of January 1, 2017, through January 15, 2017. Staff's investigation found no further violations of WAC 480-15 and Tariff 15-C. Staff recommends that the Commission waive the \$2,850 suspended portion of the penalty.

The Commission has reviewed the record in this docket and agrees that Adam's Moving has complied with the conditions of Order 01. The Commission therefore waives the suspended penalty and closes the docket.
