RE: Initial Filing

Dear Mr. Darrick Dietrich:

On June 16, 2017, Ed's Disposal, Inc. (Ed's or the Company), filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) a general rate case filing. This filing was docketed under TG-170718.

The Company's filing does not comply with the following Commission rules:

1) WAC 480-07-520 (4)

One paper and one electronic copy of all supporting work papers for the test period, which is *the most recent or most appropriate consecutive twelve-month period* [emphasis added] for which financial data are available.

State law requires the Commission to approve or suspend rate case filings within 45 days. Because this filing is missing essential information, Commission staff is unable to undertake a meaningful review.

Under <u>WAC 480-07-141</u>, the Commission may reject a filing if it is insufficient or defective. Therefore, the Company's request filed on June 16, 2017, is rejected in its entirety. However, be advised that the Company may re-file reflecting the corrections, new effective dates, and any new issues.
