Dear Mr. Johnson:

Staff's comments submitted in this docket on November 2, 2018, stated:

"For the base case, which encompasses a carbon price that begins at just below \$15/metric ton of CO2e in 2018 and ramps to just over \$40 in Washington and \$32 in Oregon, the company forecasts a reduction of 3.3 million tons of CO2e."

This is incorrect, and should read:

"For the base case, the company's carbon price begins at just below \$15/metric ton of CO2e for Washington in 2018, and about \$17/metric ton of CO2e for Oregon in 2021. The model then ramps to just over \$40/metric ton of CO2e in both states by 2037. The company forecasts a reduction of 3.3 million tons of CO2e."
