TO ALL PARTIES:

On September 8, 2017, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) served a Notice of Intent to Cancel Certification as a Charter and Excursion Carrier and/or Auto Transportation Carrier and Opportunity to Request a Hearing (Notice) on Beeline Tours LTD. and several charter and excursion carriers. The Notice informed the companies that, due to failure to submit an annual report and/or failure to pay the required regulatory fee, the Commission would cancel the companies' certificates unless they came into compliance within 30 days, or requested a hearing to demonstrate why the Commission should not revoke their registration.

On October 11, 2017, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that the following companies have all come into compliance:
