NOTICE CANCELLING BRIEF ADJUDICATIVE PROCEEDING

and

**REQUIRING SETTLEMENT DOCUMENTS
(Due March 17, 2020, by 5 p.m.)**

RE: *In the Matter of Determining the Proper Carrier Classification of, and Complaint for Penalties against: Chris Robert Miller, d/b/a Silver Limousine and Silver Transportation, Docket TE-180455*

TO ALL PARTIES:

On November 7, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a Complaint for Penalties and Notice of Brief Adjudicative Proceeding; Setting Time for Oral Statements on December 10, 2019, at 9 a.m. (Complaint) against Chris Robert Miller, d/b/a Silver Limousine and Silver Transportation, (Silver Limousine or Company) for alleged violations of Title 81 RCW.

On December 2, 2019, Silver Limousine, through its counsel, contacted the presiding officer to request a continuance of the special proceeding. The Commission concluded that a formal classification hearing was necessary. The Company and Commission staff (Staff) agreed to a hearing date of March 3, 2020, at 1:30 p.m.

On February 28, 2020, Staff contacted the presiding officer to inform the Commission that Staff and the Company have reached a settlement in principle. In its letter, Staff requests that the Commission cancel the hearing to allow the parties' time to finalize their settlement, and states that the Company supports the request.

The Commission finds good cause to cancel the brief adjudicative proceeding currently set for March 3, 2020, and to require the parties to file a settlement agreement or report on the status of negotiations by March 17, 2020.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the brief adjudicative proceeding set for March 3, 2020, at 1:30 p.m. is cancelled.

THE COMMISSION GIVES NOTICE That the parties are required to file a settlement agreement or status report in this docket by March 17, 2020, at 5 p.m.
