CAFO (ACAM), DSL, 10G OSP and bonding all bring faster broadband to more locations. Projects also include routine capex projects including drops, cards and mandatory facility moves. The funds received from the universal communications services program can be viewed as contributing to the Company's ability to perform these projects plus cover normal operating expenses. The Company opens all major projects that are budgeted early in the year thus those described above will continue throughout 2023 in addition to routine maintenance, cable additions and other projects that will be done as needed. Details for 2022 expenditures are included in Report 1 of the annual ETC filing submitted on or around July 1.

The investments described improve the multi-use network for both voice and broadband services.
