Enclosed are proposed revisions to Tariff No. 7 of Torre Refuse & Recycling d/b/a Sunshine Disposal & Recycling (G-260) in Stevens and Spokane Counties. The purpose of this filing is to increase refuse rates due to increased operating costs.

If approved, these proposed rates will generate approximately \$482,000 annually or about 10.9% on tariff revenue.

Supporting workpapers as required by WAC 480-07-520 are enclosed, along with the proposed notice to customer that will be sent on or about September 26, 2022

A copy of this notice has been provided to the chair of the county commissions of Stevens and Spokane Counties.
