Pursuant to the specified conditions contained in Order 03 in Docket UT-190574, Northwest Fiber provides an annual compliance report including the following information:

Pursuant to Condition 2, Federal Universal Service Fund (FUSF) Reporting, Ziplly Fiber Northwest, LLC's capital and expenses incurred in its buildout activities in connection with the Connect America II (CAF-II) program and all other federal high-cost universal service (FUSF) programs during the prior calendar year.
