For the past several months, we have been caught in the middle of a finger-pointing dialogue between AT&T and Qwest. Both (particularly AT&T) have denied responsibility for Qwest's failure to deliver Caller-id information on calls carried by AT&T to or from the Ocean Shores (Copalis) telephone exchange.

This information IS passed along correctly by other long-distance carriers such as MCI and Sprint.

I am hopeful that recent conservations with executives at Qwest will finally result in this problem being addressed. If not, or for other customers with analogous problems, your proposed rule is a godsend.
