RE: Correction to Compliance Filing and Other Tariff Sheet Revisions DO NOT REDOCKET—Dockets UE-191024, et al—Order 09/07/12

On March 26, 2021, PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power & Light Company (PacifiCorp or Company) submitted tariff sheets in compliance with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission's (Commission) Order 09/07/12 in Dockets UE-191024, UE-191750, UE-190929, UE-190981, UE-180778 (*Consolidated*). PacifiCorp is submitting corrections to three of the tariff sheets submitted on March 26, 2021. PacifiCorp also submits revised tariff sheets to include its proposed residential and nonresidential time of use pilot programs (Schedules 19 and 29) in the appropriate adjustment schedules. PacifiCorp requests an effective date of May 1, 2021, for all enclosed tariff sheets, which is the same date PacifiCorp requested in its original submission.

The following are the tariff sheets PacifiCorp is requesting to correct:

Original Sheet No. 19.1 Schedule 19 Residential Service – Time of Use Pilot Original Sheet No. 19.2 Schedule 19 Residential Service – Time of Use Pilot Original Sheet No. 29.1 Schedule 29 Non-Residential Time of Use Pilot

These corrected tariff sheets are intended to replace those included with PacifiCorp's original filing. The corrected Schedule 19 tariff sheets more clearly specify different pricing for customers based upon whether they qualify for Schedule 17 (Low Income Bill Assistance Program-Residential Service). The tariff sheets PacifiCorp included with its original submission did not include this differentiated pricing. The corrected Schedule 29 tariff sheet now includes a \$2.00 per month Time of Use Metering Fee, which PacifiCorp described in its testimony, but inadvertently excluded from its original submission.

In addition to the above tariff sheets PacifiCorp is requesting to correct, PacifiCorp also requests to include Schedules 19 and 29 in its adjustment schedules by revising the following tariff sheets.
