

1 On April 5, 2001, the Commission entered its Eleventh Supplemental Order in Docket UE-001952 and UE-001959 (Consolidated) approving and adopting settlement agreement, subject to conditions; dismissing proceedings; and granting other relief. Among other things, the Commission required Puget Sound Energy, Inc., (PSE) to file any revised tariff sheets necessary to effectuate the terms of the Eleventh Supplemental Order.
