As a member of the public, I am trying to comment briefly about changes to the rules (A-130355) that you are proposing re methods utilities can use to keep documents interacting with the UTC from being seen and read by the public.

In order to comment on those rules, you now require that I follow file naming rules, which are confusing to the general public, and extremely arcane, one of your examples of which I include here:

179999-WM-Resp-Mot-Cpel-ExhA-7-31-17

I understand that these rules are intended to make the lives of commissioners' and utilities' lawyers lives simpler, but is it really your intent to thereby keep the general public from participating in, and commenting on, proposed UTC rulemaking -- which has the practical effect of keeping that public from reading documents relating to the relationship between utilities and the UTC?

Shouldn't UTC's action be subject to public view by the citizens?

Isn't this an example of UTC "Catch 22" ?
