On Tuesday, August 17, 2004, the Complainant submitted a letter to the Commission electronically, requesting a 30-day extension of time to file a petition for administrative review. The Complainant requests the extension in order to review documents he has requested from the Commission through a public records request.

On Friday, August 20, 2004, Verizon Northwest Inc. notified the Commission orally that it did not object to the Complainant's request. Verizon does not request an extension of the 10-day response period provided in WAC 480-07-825(4)(b).

A petition for administrative review in this proceeding must be filed with the Commission by Monday, September 27, 2004.
