As you are aware, on November 8, 2018, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission issued Order 01 in the referenced docket imposing penalties in the amount of \$21,000 on All Star Transfer, Inc., for violations of the Commissions laws and rules. On January 16, 2019, a Final Notice was sent to All Star Transfer, Inc., in the amount of \$21,000, which was due on receipt.

To date, the Commission has not received the balance due.

This is to notify you that the Commission intends to forward your outstanding debt to a collection agency for collection. You likely will incur additional expenses and fees, including costs of collection, attorney's fees, and interest. These expenses and fees will be added to your outstanding \$21,000 balance.
