Late Fees: Late fees are assessed on delinquent accounts. The percentage amount or minimum charge for late payments is one percent (1.0%) of the unpaid balance or one dollar (\$1.00), whichever is greater.

Missed service due to unsafe weather conditions, road conditions, natural disaster or when government authority restricts access to local roads.** A company is not required to collect solid waste when the company determines that it is unsafe to operate due to weather conditions, road conditions, natural disaster, or when government authority restricts access to local roads. a. The company is not obligated to extend credit to customers for missed service if the company collects the customers' accumulated solid waste on the next scheduled service date on which the company deems it to be safe to operate. The company will not charge for extra waste set out (except provided in Item 207, if applicable) in addition to customers' normal receptacle(s), if the amount of extra waste does not exceed the amount that reasonably would be expected to accumulate due to missed service.

b.

If the company does not collect a customer's accumulated solid waste on the next scheduled service date on which the company determines it is safe to operate, the company is required to give a credit, proportionate to the customer's monthly service charge, for all missed service(s).
