RE: *Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission v. Washingtons Movers LLC*
Commission Staff Recommendation to Waive Suspended Penalties of Order 01
Docket TV-200635 and TV-200636 (*Consolidated*)

Dear Ms. Maxwell:

On August 26, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission entered Order 01, Consolidating Dockets; Approving Safety Management Plan; Upgrading Safety Rating; Imposing and Suspending Penalties in Dockets TV-200635 and TV-200636. Order 01 assessed a \$4,050 penalty against Washingtons Movers LLC, (Washingtons Movers or Company) and suspended a \$2,500 portion of the penalty for two years, and then waived, subject to the following conditions:

- (1) Commission staff (Staff) conduct a follow-up investigation approximately six months from the date of Order 01;
- (2) Washingtons Movers must not incur any repeat violations of critical regulations; and
- (3) The Company pay the \$1,550 portion of the penalty that is not suspended.

On September 10, 2020, Washingtons Movers paid the \$1,550 portion of the penalty that was not suspended.

On February 8, 2022, Staff completed the required follow-up investigation. The Company did not receive any repeat critical violations.

Staff finds that Washingtons Movers satisfied the conditions of Order 01 and recommends that the \$2,500 suspended penalty be waived.
