CREA Data Request 0011

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Under the Company's revisions to the Net Removal Tariff, please provide the total cost the Company expects a typical residential customer would need to pay to permanently disconnect and remove facilities under each of the following scenarios:

- a. The customer pays the Actual Cost of Removal;
- b. The customer purchases the Facilities at Fair Market Value;
- c. The Company abandons and decommissions the Facilities.

Please ensure that the Stranded Cost Recovery Fee is included in your answer.

Please provide all data supporting your response to each scenario.

Response to CREA Data Request 0011

The Company objects to this request on the grounds that it is not reasonably calculated to lead to the discovery of admissible evidence. Subject to and without waiving this objection, the Company responds as follows:

- a. The Company has not prepared the requested analysis. The actual cost of removal is specific to the facilities in place to provide electric service to the departing residential customer. Accordingly, the Company is unable to provide an estimate.
- b. The Company has not prepared the requested analysis. Fair market value would be calculated based on market conditions at the time of disposition of the asset. Accordingly, the Company is unable to provide an estimate.
- c. The Company has not prepared the requested analysis. The Company will only abandon and decommission facilities when service is negatively impacted or a safety issue is present. Each such assessment will be specific to the facilities in place. Accordingly, the Company is unable to provide an estimate.

The Stranded Cost Recovery Fee is \$6,153 per revisions to Pacific Power's Schedule 300.

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
