Dear Amanda Maxwell:

On December 14, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Order 09/07/12 Rejecting Tariff Sheets; Approving and Adopting Settlement Stipulation; Approving and Adopting Settlement Stipulation Subject to Conditions; Authorizing and Requiring Compliance filing in the above-referenced docket. Order 09/ 07/ 12, among other things, required PacifiCorp, d/b/a Pacific Power & Light Company (Company) to file a Disconnection Reduction Plan.

On December 30, 2021, PacifiCorp filed with the Commission its Disconnection Reduction Plan. The Company's Report shows its existing business practices, energy assistance options, plan for reducing disconnections, and reports on disconnection metrics.

Commission Staff (Staff) reviewed the compliance filing provided by PacifiCorp dated December 30, 2021, and finds that it contains sufficient detail with respect to the Company's current practices and plans for reducing disconnections. Therefore, Staff believes that the filing complies with the Commission's Order 09/07/12, entered December 14, 2020.
