Mr. Fassburg,

I am in-house counsel for PCA and I'm responding to your letter of December 21, 2021 regarding services provided by Jammie's to the mill. Thank you for the courtesy information provided in your letter. PCA has looked into the matter and contacted WUTC directly. Jammie provides services to the mill beyond solid waste collection and transportation. Jammie's services include vacuum truck services, water blasting, general industrial cleaning, tank cleaning, railroad track cleaning, and waste transportation and disposal. Solid waste transportation and disposal is incidental to the overall services provided by Jammies, and therefore, Jammie's services are considered exempt under WAC 480-70-011(1)(g). Jammie's is only required to obtain a Common Carrier Permit, which they have. Please see <https://www.utc.wa.gov/company/48673>

We confirmed the regulatory and permitting requirements with Solid Waste Enforcement Division with the WUTC and were satisfied that Jammie's has the necessary permits to continue to provide services for PCA. Based on our review, PCA will continue to partner with Jammie's for all the services currently provided.
