TO ALL PARTIES:

On December 14, 2020, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Final Order 09/07/12, Rejecting Tariff Sheets; Approving and Adopting Settlement Stipulation; Approving and Adopting Settlement Stipulation Subject to Conditions; and Authorizing and Requiring Compliance Filing (Order 09) in Dockets UE-191024, UE-190750, UE-190929, UE-190981, and UE-180778 (*Consolidated*). Order 09, among other things, required PacifiCorp, d/b/a Pacific Power & Light Company (Company) to file a Disconnection Reduction Plan.

On December 30, 2021, PacifiCorp filed with the Commission its Disconnection Reduction Plan. The Company's Report shows its existing business practices, energy assistance options, plan for reducing disconnections, and reports on disconnection metrics.

On July 27, 2022, Commission staff (Staff) filed with the Commission a letter indicating that it believes that the filing complies with the Commission's Order 09.

The Commission has reviewed the Company's Disconnection Reduction Plan and finds that the report complies with Order 09.
