Pursuant to the Sixth Prehearing Order, attached please the original and 8 copies of a revised matrix. The parties have identified the following issues as issues for which there is no disputed issue of fact and which can be decided on the written submissions of the parties:

Issue 2-3 - Application of rates in Exhibit A
Issue 2-4 - Effective date of legally binding changes
Issues 9-56 and 9-56(a) - Service eligibility criteria audits

Please note that a large number of issues have closed, as is detailed in the matrix. The parties anticipate that other issues will be submitted for decision without cross examination at the hearing. Neither party is in a position to commit to such action until the final round of testimony is filed on January 12, 2007.

Please also note that the language proposals of each party are not updated in the matrix.
