

This letter is to advise you that Verizon has modified its wholesale system interfaces and processes to allow mechanized processing of LSR requests for loop modifications that may be required under particular interconnection agreements pursuant to the FCC's Report and Order and Order on Remand and Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, CC Docket Nos. 01-338, 96-98, and 98-147, FCC 03-36, 18 FCC Rcd 16978, released on August 21, 2003 (the "Triennial Review Order").¹

Verizon will introduce these changes in October 2004 throughout its serving areas. The associated business rules have been provided through the Verizon Change Management Process and are described in the October 2004 Change Management release. You may obtain loop modifications only if your interconnection agreement contains the requisite terms, conditions, and rates to implement the pertinent provisions of the Triennial Review Order (except to the extent that certain interconnection agreements already require Verizon to perform certain loop conditioning activities, such as removal of load coil and bridge tap, pursuant to FCC rules that pre-dated the Triennial Review Order).²

The attached documents list the loop modifications that Verizon will perform on loops to the extent required by particular interconnection agreements. As described in the October 2004 Change Management release, each modification has a corresponding alpha identifier that will be used to alert you to modifications required to provision particular UNE Loop orders, so that you may confirm whether you wish to proceed with or cancel the order. The charges associated with such facility modifications are identified in the pricing attachment to the Triennial Review Order amendment that you must have executed in order to obtain loop modifications (or in a pre-existing pricing attachment in the case of interconnection agreements that already required Verizon to perform certain loop conditioning activities, such as removal of load coil and bridge tap, pursuant to FCC rules that pre-existed the Triennial Review Order).

¹ The mechanized processing of ASR requests was addressed in a previous notice dated February 20, 2004.


