
VERIFIED STATEMENT OF AFFILIATED INTEREST TRANSACTION

**AMENDMENT NO. 13 TO  
WHOLESALE SERVICES AGREEMENT**

THIS AMENDMENT NO. 13 (this "Amendment") is by and between Qwest Communications Company, LLC ("Qwest") and Qwest Corporation ("Customer") and amends the Wholesale Services Agreement between Customer and Qwest dated effective as of July 29, 2004, as may have been previously amended by amendment, addenda or rate change notification (the "Agreement"). This Amendment shall be effective as of the date when it has been signed by both Parties (the "Amendment Effective Date"). All capitalized terms used herein which are not defined herein shall have the definitions ascribed to them in the Agreement. The Parties hereby agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

**1. New Services.**<sup>1</sup> The service descriptions and related rate exhibits set forth in Exhibits F-OCN1, F-OCN2, F-OCN9 and F-OCN12 attached to this Amendment (the "New Services") shall be added to the Amendment and shall replace and supersede in their entirety certain service descriptions and rates as previously attached to the Agreement (or any amendment, addenda or rate change notification to the Agreement), including without limitation, Exhibits E1, E2, E3, F1, F2 and F3 (the "Old Services"). The list of Service Exhibits in the "Applicable Services" portion of the Agreement shall be deemed revised by the deletion of the Old Services and the addition of the New Services. Qwest agrees to provide the New Services in accordance with the terms of the Agreement and this Amendment. The terms, rates and discounts, if any, for the New Services shall be effective as of the first business day of Customer's next full monthly billing cycle following the Amendment Effective Date, provided, however that the rates for any Old Services in place as of the Amendment Effective Date shall continue to apply until the expiration of the applicable service term for such Old Services and until changed pursuant to Customer order.

**2. Effective Date.** This Amendment shall be effective as of the date it is executed by the last Party to execute (the "Amendment Effective date") and be deemed incorporated by reference into the Agreement; provided however, that if under applicable law, this Agreement or notice thereof must be filed with a governmental entity, including, but not limited to, a state public utility commission, this Agreement shall not become effective with respect to the jurisdiction having such requirements until such filing have occurred. In particular, this Agreement shall not be effective with respect to the State of Washington until it is filed with Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission. The terms, rates and discounts, if any, for the New Services shall be effective as of the Amendment Effective Date.

**3. Miscellaneous.** All other terms and conditions in the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect and be binding upon the Parties. This Amendment and the Agreement set forth the entire understanding between the Parties as to the subject matter herein, and in the event there are any inconsistencies between the two documents, the terms of this Amendment shall control. To the extent that the terms of any New Service exhibit are inconsistent with the terms of this Amendment or the Agreement, the terms of the New Service exhibit shall control.

1. REQWEST® SWITCHLESS RESELLER – OCN BILLING SERVICE DESCRIPTION.

1.1 Qwest will provide 2 primary ReQwest Switchless Reseller – OCN Billing Services ("ReQwest Services") and several other services ("Other Services" and collectively with the ReQwest Services, the "Service") pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Agreement and this Exhibit F-OCN1. Except as set forth in this Exhibit, capitalized terms will have the definitions assigned to them in the Agreement.

1.2 ReQwest Services. The ReQwest Services consist of 2 wholesale products for telecommunications carriers available for resale in which Qwest originates and terminates certain voice traffic to domestic, international and extended-U.S. locations listed in Exhibit F-OCN2 (the "Rate Exhibit"), as ordered by Customer. "Domestic" means the continental U.S., Puerto Rico and the U.S. Virgin Islands. The "Extended-U.S. Locations" are Alaska, Hawaii, Puerto Rico, the U.S. Virgin Islands, Guam, the Midway/ Wake Islands, and the North Mariana Islands. "International" means those countries listed in the International section of the Rate Exhibit. The Rate Exhibit may be delivered to Customer separately from, and in a different form than, the Agreement, or the amendment thereto, of which it is a part. "Billing Cycle" means the month-long period, not necessarily beginning on the first of the month, for which Qwest invoices Customer for ReQwest Services.

Qwest reserves the right to refuse to accept, suspend or limit any or all of Customer's traffic that Qwest believes is adversely affecting other customers or the Qwest network.

The ReQwest Services are Reseller 1+ Outbound Services and Reseller 8XX Inbound Services.

(a) "Reseller 1+ Outbound Services" are:

(i) "Switchless 1+ Outbound Service" (switched-to-switched) which provides end-to-end call origination and termination. Traffic originates from the End User's telephone number (Automated Number Identifier or "ANI") or premises equipment and terminates to the called party. Switched ANIs are assigned to Qwest's carrier identification code ("CIC"); and

(ii) "End User Dedicated 1+ Outbound Service" (dedicated-to-switched) which allows traffic to originate from a dedicated circuit between the End User's premises equipment and the nearest available Qwest Point of Presence ("POP") and terminate to the called party. The End User Dedicated 1+ Outbound Service must NOT be used by Customer to aggregate traffic from multiple End Users.

(b) "Reseller 8XX Inbound Services" are:

(i) "Switchless 8XX Inbound Service" (switched-to-switched) which provides end-to-end call origination and termination. Traffic originates from Domestic locations and Canada, and terminates to the End User's ANI or premises equipment; and

(ii) "End User Dedicated 8XX Inbound Service" (switched-to-dedicated) which allows traffic to originate from a Domestic location or Canada and terminate to a dedicated circuit between Qwest's nearest available POP and the End User's premises equipment. The End User Dedicated 8XX Inbound Service must NOT be used by Customer to aggregate traffic from multiple End Users.

(c) Blocking. Notwithstanding the terms of this Exhibit, due to high volumes of fraudulent activity in certain locations, Qwest will not provide Reseller 8XX Inbound Service for calls originating from Guam or any other countries using the North American Numbering Plan (NANP), except for Domestic locations and Canada, in the absence of a mutually-agreed amendment to this Exhibit, despite the presence of rates for such countries in the Rate Exhibit. If Qwest delivers such traffic for any reason, the rates in the Rate Exhibit will apply.

1.3 Other Services. Qwest may provide the following Other Services in combination with the ReQwest Services.

(a) Qwest "Worldcard Service". Qwest's Worldcard Service provides toll-free access from Domestic locations to certain direct-dial countries worldwide, and also allows overseas travelers to place calls to the U.S. or to other countries. The Worldcard Service may be integrated into many of Qwest's invoicing, reporting, and network management tools. The dialing guide, available at [www.Qwest.com](http://www.Qwest.com), provides additional details about the Worldcard Service, including international access numbers and applicable restrictions. Worldcard's International operator services provide collect and other operator-assisted calling from a foreign country back to the U.S. Qwest will bill Worldcard International operator service assisted calls at rates based on the originating country rates.

- (b) "700 PIC Service". Customer may submit a written order for Qwest reseller 700 identification service which provides a unique 700 number for Customer use. To use the 700 PIC Service, Customer must provide a recorded message in .WAV format to Qwest of no more than 15 seconds, which all persons, including non-End Users, will hear when calling the specified 700 number. Customer may not represent to End Users that such 700 number is the universal 700 number for PIC verification (700-555-4141). The 700 PIC Service is offered by Qwest only in conjunction with Switchless 1+ Outbound Services.
- (c) Domestic Operator Service. When 0+ long distance or 00 long distance is dialed, Qwest provides Domestic operator services under the Qwest name to End Users. Qwest operators offer multiple billing methods to the End User (e.g., station-to-station (billed back to origination), collect, third party, local exchange carrier calling card or major credit card). Qwest will bill each Domestic operator services call at rates based on the originating Local Access and Transport Area ("LATA") of the call, according to tariffed rates. Customer shall inform (i) new End Users prior to delivering telecommunications services to them and (ii) existing End Users within 30 calendar days of the effective date of this Exhibit, that Qwest will perform such Domestic operator services directly to the End User and that Qwest will invoice directly for such Domestic operator services.
- (d) "1+ Directory Assistance Service." 1+ Directory Assistance Service provides End Users with access, via a Qwest directory assistance operator/agent, to local and national published listing information.
- (e) "8XX Directory Assistance Service." Upon Customer's written request, Qwest will provide 8XX directory assistance listings in the National Toll Free Directory Assistance database. Customer understands this 8XX Directory Assistance Service is ultimately provided by a third party and subject to the policies and procedures set forth by such third party.
- (f) ITFS/UIFN. Qwest International Toll Free Service ("ITFS") and Universal International Freephone Number Service ("UIFN") are end-to-end services which allow End Users to originate toll-free calls from an International location, including Canada, and terminate them to the continental U.S. and Canada. Termination is available in the continental U.S. for switched and dedicated services, and in Canada for switched services only. Some countries may not accept new orders, may offer service in only some areas, and may not accept portability orders. Customer must check availability in the ITFS/UIFN Availability Matrix, which matrix is available from Qwest. For each country where ITFS is available and requested, Qwest will assign Customer its own individual toll-free number for call origination. These numbers are specific to the country of call origin and have different toll-free dialing formats, e.g., the U.S. uses the "8XX" prefix to identify a toll-free number. UIFN offers a single international toll-free number for calls that originate in participating countries. These participating countries will follow the same UIFN dialing format (+800 XXXX XXXX) which is administered and regulated by the International Telecommunications Union. Though more restrictive than ITFS (because participating countries need to cooperate to ensure one number can access each respective country's telephone system), UIFN provides the user with one convenient access number. UIFN is available in more than 30 countries around the world. In certain countries, the following applications are not permitted for ITFS/UIFN: calling card, voice response unit, operator services, third-country termination, dial tone, dial up access, dead air and any other response the individual carrier deems inappropriate to ITFS/UIFN. Originating carriers treat all carriers equally regarding these restrictions. Restrictions on usage are imposed on all other carriers, including Qwest, by the originating carriers. ITFS/UIFN service orders violating the restrictive guidelines of the originating carrier may not be processed by Qwest's ITFS/UIFN implementation group. Toll-free originating carriers finding usage in violation of their guidelines can, and will, block toll-free numbers on the originating side of the call without notice or appeal. Carriers may change their restrictions to be more restrictive without notice to Qwest. Information regarding which country has this type of limitation is located in the ITFS/UIFN Availability Matrix. If Customer requests that Qwest block toll-free numbers, and Qwest is the Resp Org (as defined in Section 2.14) of such toll-free numbers, Qwest will use reasonable efforts to effectuate such blocking request; provided, however, Customer will continue to be responsible for all charges for all such calls until the blockage becomes effective. Qwest may, as it deems appropriate, after 30 days notice, disconnect any ITFS/UIFN number which does not generate at least 60 minutes of usage during any period of 3 consecutive Billing Cycles.
- (g) Project Account Codes. A Project Account Code ("PAC") is used for internal call tracking and accounting and to control the ability of employees to make certain telephone calls. PAC indexes consist of system-generated numbers that group specific verified PACs together for tracking purposes. Qwest reserves the right to release unused PAC indexes back into the pool of available PAC indexes for use by other customers in accordance with Qwest's business rules, which may change from time to time. In addition, Qwest offers predefined verified PACs ranging from 2 to 12 digits in length as well as associated indexes from which customers may select.

**2. RATES.**

Domestic and Extended-U.S. Locations Rates.

**2.1 Switchless 1+ Outbound Service and Switchless 8XX Inbound Service.**

(a) For Switchless 1+ Outbound Service and Switchless 8XX Inbound Service, Qwest will use the originating information in the call stream data (such as Jurisdiction Information Parameter (JIP), originating ANI or Calling Party Number (CPN)) ("Origination Information") to determine the LATA and state in which the call originates, and the terminating information in the call stream data (such as terminating ANI or called party number) ("Termination Information") to determine the LATA and state in which the call terminates. Qwest will use that information to determine jurisdiction (intrastate or interstate) (the "Call Jurisdiction"). Qwest will also identify the operating company number ("OCN") of the originating and terminating carriers.

(b) For Switchless 1+ Outbound Service calls to the continental U.S., Qwest will use the Call Jurisdiction, the originating carrier OCN, and the originating LATA to assign the applicable rate from the Rate Exhibit, based on the originating location of the call.

(c) For Switchless 1+ Outbound Service calls to Extended-U.S. Locations, Qwest will use the Call Jurisdiction, the terminating carrier OCN, and the terminating LATA to assign the applicable rate from the Rate Exhibit, based on the terminating location of the call.

(d) For Switchless 8XX Inbound Service calls to the continental U.S., Qwest will use the Call Jurisdiction, the terminating carrier OCN, and the terminating LATA to assign the applicable rate from the Rate Exhibit, based on the terminating location of the call.

(e) For Switchless 8XX Inbound Service calls from Extended-U.S. Locations, Qwest will use the Call Jurisdiction, the originating carrier OCN, and the originating LATA to assign the applicable rate from the Rate Exhibit, based on the originating location of the call.

**2.2 End User Dedicated 1+ Outbound Service and End User Dedicated 8XX Inbound Service.**

(a) For End User Dedicated 1+ Outbound Service, Qwest will use Direct Access Line ("DAL") information to determine the originating location of the call, and Termination Information to determine the terminating LATA. Qwest will use that information to determine the Call Jurisdiction. Qwest will use the Call Jurisdiction, the terminating carrier OCN, and the terminating LATA to assign the applicable rate from the Rate Exhibit, based on the terminating location of the call.

(b) For End User Dedicated 8XX Inbound Service, Qwest will use DAL information to determine the terminating location of the call, and Origination Information to determine the originating LATA. Qwest will use that information to determine the Call Jurisdiction. Qwest will use the Call Jurisdiction, the originating carrier OCN, the originating LATA to assign the applicable rate from the Rate Exhibit, based on the originating location of the call.

**2.3 Billing Increments.** The Domestic and Extended-U.S. Location ReQwest Services rates in the Rate Exhibit are for full minutes and are billed in 6-second increments.

**2.4 Short Duration Calls.** If the percentage of Customer's completed calls equal to or less than 6 seconds in length (each, a "Short Duration Call") for any Billing Cycle meets or exceeds the Short Call Percentage Threshold, Qwest may charge the additional Short Call Surcharge for each Short Duration Call during such Billing Cycle (including those Short Duration Calls under the Short Call Percentage Threshold). The Short Call Percentage Threshold and the Short Call Surcharge are stated in the Rate Exhibit.

**2.5 Rate Changes.** Except as stated elsewhere in this Exhibit, all rates, rate-classification criteria, thresholds, charges, surcharges, and discounts are subject to change by Qwest upon 30 calendar days written notice to Customer. If Customer does not comply with its obligations as set forth in this Exhibit, Qwest may, in addition to any and all other remedies that Qwest may have under the Agreement, at law or in equity, change any and all Domestic and Extended-U.S. Location rates, rate-classification criteria, thresholds, charges, surcharges, and discounts upon 10 calendar days written notice to Customer.

International Rates.

2.6 Qwest charges for 1+ outbound International termination according to the maximum number of digits at the beginning of the dialed number, not including any appropriate dialed prefix (e.g., "011" for international or "1" for Numbering Plan Area ("NPA")), which match exactly the NPA or country codes, plus city/mobile area codes, specified in the Rate Exhibit. 1+ outbound International termination is subject to the availability of facilities to, and in, the country at issue. The 1+ outbound International termination rates in the Rate Exhibit are for full minutes.

2.7 All International calls, other than calls to Mexico, are billed a 30-second minimum, and thereafter, in 6-second increments (rounded to the next highest 1/10th of a minute per call). Calls to Mexico are billed a 60-second minimum, and thereafter, in 60-second increments.

2.8 Qwest may increase International rates and charges, and eliminate or decrease discounts, upon at least 5 calendar days prior written notice. Qwest may decrease International rates and charges, and provide or increase discounts, immediately and without written notice, or as otherwise specified in writing.

Other Services' Rates.

2.9 Worldcard Service. Qwest will charge the Worldcard Service rates, including without limitation, the Worldcard Operator Services charges in the Rate Exhibit, according to the originating and terminating points of the call and the listed billing increments.

2.10 700 PIC Service. Qwest will charge the 700 PIC Service rates in the Rate Exhibit.

2.11 Directory Assistance. Qwest will charge the 1+ Directory Assistance Service and 8XX Directory Assistance Service rates and charges in the Rate Exhibit.

2.12 ITFS/UIFN. Qwest will charge the ITFS and UIFN rates in the Rate Exhibit. All ITFS and UIFN calls must originate from locations listed in the Rate Exhibit.

2.13 Enhanced Features and Ancillary Services. Certain services and enhanced features are subject to additional charges, surcharges and fees as provided in the Enhanced Toll Free Features Charges and Ancillary Services and Charges sections of the Rate Exhibit.

2.14 8XX SMS Number Storage Fee. For each active 8XX number in Qwest's network provisioning systems for which Qwest acts as the Responsible Organization ("Resp Org"), Qwest will charge the 8XX SMS Number Storage Fee in the Rate Exhibit.

Other Rate Terms.

2.15 Payphone Surcharge. Customer will pay Qwest the Payphone Compensation Surcharge stated in the Rate Exhibit for each Qwest-completed, coinless, payphone-originated, toll free call. The Service provided pursuant to this Exhibit does not support Telecommunication Relay Service, as defined by the Communications Act of 1996, as amended, and relevant FCC rules ("TRS"). Accordingly, TRS providers will not be exempt from Payphone Compensation Surcharge billing and payments with respect to 8XX numbers used in conjunction with TRS.

2.16 Carrier DAL Use Prohibited. CUSTOMER MAY NOT DIRECT ANY CARRIER DAL TRAFFIC OVER AN END USER DAL. SUCH USE IS A MATERIAL BREACH OF THIS EXHIBIT AND QWEST MAY, IN ADDITION TO ANY AND ALL OTHER REMEDIES THAT QWEST MAY HAVE UNDER THE AGREEMENT, AT LAW OR IN EQUITY, BILL, AND BACKBILL, ALL SUCH CALLS AT THE INTRASTATE RATES IN THE RATE EXHIBIT. "CARRIER DAL" MEANS A DEDICATED CIRCUIT THAT IS CONNECTED TO A SWITCHING PLATFORM AND HAS THE ABILITY TO AGGREGATE TRAFFIC FROM, OR DELIVER TRAFFIC TO, MULTIPLE END-USERS.

2.17 Regulatory-related Rate Adjustments. In the event of Regulatory Activity and notwithstanding any other provision herein to the contrary, Qwest may, upon prior written notice when reasonably practicable, modify, change or add to (a) the rates and charges, (b) the Service, and (c) the other terms and conditions contained in this Exhibit, to reflect the impact of, or to effect, such Regulatory Activity.

2.18 Bulk Standard Rounding. Qwest invoices for the ReQwest Services to the full cent level; however, Qwest tracks call charges to the 4th decimal place. Qwest uses "Bulk Standard Rounding" to convert from the 4th decimal place to full cents. Bulk Standard Rounding rounds (a) up the amount billed for a call to the 2nd decimal place, if the 3rd and 4th decimal places of a call charge are equal to, or exceed, \$0.0050, and (b) down the amount billed for a call to the 2nd decimal place, if the 3rd and 4th decimal places of a call charge are less than \$0.0050. The difference between the billed charge and the actual call charge, negative or positive ("Difference"), is applied to the next call, and such call's actual charges plus the Difference are Bulk Standard Rounded in the same manner to determine the billed charge for such call. This process repeats for all calls.

2.19 Revenue Discounts. During each Billing Cycle in which Customer complies with the terms of this Exhibit, Customer will receive the discount set forth in the Revenue Discount Schedule in the Rate Exhibit which corresponds with the total Contributory Charges invoiced under the Agreement (and any other eligible separate Qwest wholesale services agreement) during that Billing Cycle. The applicable monthly discount will only be applied against Customer's Domestic and Extended-U.S. Locations interstate ReQwest Services use.

**3. PROVISIONING AND OTHER ISSUES.**

3.1 Orders must be complete and correct or they (a) will be returned to Customer for correction and resubmission, or (b) may drop out of the fulfillment process. If the records of the local exchange carrier ("LEC") and those supplied to Qwest by Customer do not match, the LEC may reject the order from Qwest. If the End User has been switched to Qwest service by the LEC, (i) the End User will be billed by the LEC for any use of Qwest telecommunications services, (ii) the End User will receive Qwest services at Qwest's then-standard rates, and (iii) Qwest will receive and retain all such revenue (e.g., casual calling).

3.2 At any time, Qwest may audit Customer's ANIs present in the Qwest billing system. Customer must pay all charges for ordered Service, even if the order prepared by Customer contains errors. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Agreement limiting Qwest's right to backbill, Qwest may backbill Customer for any amounts that were not billed due to Customer's order entry errors, and Customer must pay any such backbilled amounts.

3.3 If the LEC, for whatever reason, has not designated Qwest as each End User's primary interexchange carrier ("PIC"), the End User will be billed in accordance with the records of the LEC. Each Party will use reasonable efforts to notify the other Party of any rejection of order installation by the LEC. Customer must determine the correct information for reinstallation of the order. Qwest has no liability for any acts or omissions of LECs, including without limitation, those related to PIC changes.

3.4 Customer must use the on-line order entry system provided by Qwest, which may change from time-to-time. Customer may be required to execute other agreements, including without limitation, software license agreements, related to the use of such system.

4. PIC AUTHORIZATIONS. For each ANI ordered by Customer, Qwest requires Customer to obtain either a signed letter of authorization ("LOA") or a third-party verification (TPV) as those terms are used in state and FCC rules ("PIC Authorization"). For each ANI ordered by Customer that involves a change of carrier CIC where a LEC or CLEC acts as the executing carrier under state and FCC rules (a "CIC Transfer"), Qwest may demand proof of PIC Authorization before processing such order and may refuse to accept or process the ANI until Customer produces a copy of the PIC Authorization. Furthermore, Qwest assumes no responsibility for the maintenance or tracking of ANIs involved in a CIC Transfer and lacking a PIC Authorization.

**5. PIC DISPUTES.**

5.1 In the event of a dispute involving (a) an unauthorized change of ANI between carriers sharing a Qwest CIC where Qwest acts as the executing carrier under state and FCC rules (an "ANI Transfer Dispute") or (b) an unauthorized CIC Transfer (a "CIC Transfer Dispute" and collectively with an ANI Transfer Dispute, a "PIC Dispute"), Qwest may demand proof of PIC Authorization. Customer must provide the proof of PIC Authorization for each ANI in dispute within 10 calendar days of Qwest's demand. If Qwest does not receive the demanded proof within 10 calendar days, Qwest may charge Customer (i) the LEC invoicing fee in the Rate Exhibit (PIC Disputes - LEC Fee) plus (ii) the PIC Disputes - Qwest Admin. Fee in the Rate Exhibit ("PIC Admin. Fee") for each ANI in dispute. These fees are in addition to any other remedies Qwest may have in this Section 5.

5.2. Customer is responsible to End Users for any charges or credits required by federal or state rules, including LEC switching fees, as well as any usage charges or other costs associated with each PIC Dispute.

5.3 If the number of CIC Transfer Disputes in a calendar month for which Customer does not deliver to Qwest proper PIC Authorizations as required by Section 5.1 above exceeds 2% of the total number of ANIs added during the prior calendar month ("PIC Dispute Percentage"), Qwest reserves the right to apply the remedial measures set forth below to each of Customer's accounts until Customer's PIC Dispute Percentage falls to 2% or less for 2 consecutive calendar months.

(a) Qwest may send a warning letter to Customer the first month that Customer's PIC Dispute Percentage exceeds 2%.

(b) If Customer's PIC Dispute Percentage exceeds 2% for 2 consecutive months, Qwest may send a Phase 1 letter to Customer. During Phase 1 Qwest may restrict or disconnect Customer's automatic transfer options. During this period, if Customer requests that an ANI already existing in Qwest's billing system be provisioned to its account, the order will reject as "WTN Not Transferable." Customer will need to provide proof of PIC Authorization to its Qwest Account Manager to facilitate the manual transfer of the WTN. If Customer fails to provide proof of PIC Authorization, the WTN will not be provisioned to Customer's account.

(c) If Customer's PIC Dispute Percentage exceeds 2% for 3 consecutive months:

1. Qwest may terminate this Exhibit upon 5 calendar days prior written notice, with no opportunity to cure; or

2. Qwest may send a Phase 2 letter to Customer. During Phase 2, (A) the PIC Admin. Fee will double, and (B) Qwest will suspend all of Customer's access to add-ANI functionality, which may negatively affect other services purchased by Customer from Qwest.

(d) Notwithstanding any provision of this Exhibit to the contrary, Qwest may terminate this Exhibit upon 5 calendar days prior written notice, with no opportunity to cure, if Customer's PIC Dispute Percentage exceeds 2% for 5 or more months in any 12 month period.

5.4 If an ANI Transfer Dispute occurs and Customer does not deliver proper PIC Authorizations to Qwest as required by Section 5.1 above, then Qwest reserves the right to restrict or disconnect Customer's automatic transfer options. While Customer's automatic transfer options are disconnected, if Customer requests that an ANI already existing in Qwest's billing system be provisioned to its account, the order will reject as "WTN Not Transferable." Customer will need to provide proof of PIC Authorization to its Qwest Account Manager to facilitate the manual transfer of the WTN. If Customer fails to provide proof of PIC Authorization, the WTN will not be provisioned to Customer's account.

5.5 If a LEC or a regulatory entity assesses Qwest any charge, fee, fine or forfeiture for improper or inadequate PIC authorizations relating to ReQwest Services, Customer must promptly reimburse Qwest for all such charges. Qwest will pass through any such charge, fine, forfeiture or fee without additional markup.

5.6 Nothing herein will be construed to limit Qwest's ability to pursue any and all remedies available to Qwest under the Agreement, in law or in equity, with respect to PIC Disputes and any related claims or proceedings.

6. **CANCELLATION, BLOCKING, AND DISCONNECTION OF REQWEST SERVICE.** Without affecting any other Customer obligations herein, Customer may cancel, disconnect, or terminate a portion of ReQwest Services when an End User has provided a new PIC authorization to another carrier. Customer is financially responsible for all Service until such time that the new PIC change is implemented.

7. **CUSTOMER OBLIGATIONS.**

7.1 Customer must enter each End User ANI in Qwest's then-current on-line order entry system, and is responsible for assigning each ANI to the appropriate Qwest product account. Customer waives any and all claims against Qwest arising out of Customer's failure to enter and assign such ANIs to the appropriate Qwest product account.

7.2 Customer agrees that it will prohibit its End Users from using any 8XX number, or other telephone number advertised or widely understood to be toll-free, in a manner that would violate FCC rule 47 CFR 64.1504.

8. **LIABILITY.** Without limiting the Agreement, Qwest is not liable for: (a) any act or omission of the Number Administration and Service Center ("NASC"), other Resp Orgs, or any other carrier providing a portion of the Service; (b) any loss or damage sustained by Customer, its 8XX subscriber or any third party by reason of defects or malfunctions in the facilities, hardware or software not provided by Qwest or not directly under its control; or (c) by reason of errors made by NASC in connection with the Service Management System ("SMS").

9. **TOLL-FREE SERVICES PORTABILITY AND RESP ORG.**

9.1 Qwest will provide Switchless 8XX Inbound Service and End User Dedicated 8XX Inbound Service to End Users desiring to keep their then-current 8XX number provided that: (a) the End User signs an LOA designating Customer or Customer's third party provider as the Resp Org for the toll-free number; (b) Customer or Customer's third party provider, as applicable, signs an LOA designating Qwest as the Resp Org for the toll-free number; and (c) Customer provides any additional or different LOA(s) required by Qwest to provide such Service.

9.2 Qwest will provide International Reseller 8XX Inbound Service to End Users desiring to keep their then-current 8XX number provided that: (a) the End User signs an LOA designating Customer or Customer's third party provider as the Resp Org for the ITFS/UIFN number; (b) Customer or Customer's third party provider, as applicable, signs an LOA designating Qwest as the Resp Org for the ITFS/UIFN number; (c) the country of origination is willing to port the existing originating number from the current carrier to Qwest; and (d) Customer provides any additional or different LOA(s) required by Qwest to provide such Service.

9.3 Qwest agrees to act as the Resp Org and manage and administer Customer's records in the SMS. Qwest's responsibilities are limited to coordinating data entry, record changes, trouble acceptance, and trouble shooting referrals and clearances. Qwest will also provide coordination to provision, maintain and test the 8XX data base service between various entities, such as LECs, IXCs, NASC, and SMS. As the Resp Org, Qwest is limited in the number of 8XX number reservations it may hold. Reservations will be available on a first-come, first-served basis. Customer's reservations may at no time exceed 7.5% of Customer's active toll free numbers or 2,000 toll free numbers, whichever is greater. Reservations cannot be held for more than 45 calendar days. At the end of the reservation period, the toll free number will be returned to the pool of numbers available for general assignment. Customer will make available to Qwest an 8XX number and personnel, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, for Resp Org-related trouble reporting and resolution. Customer will use its best efforts to assist Qwest in the resolution of any End User dispute.

9.4 For all 8XX numbers for which Qwest is the Resp Org, Qwest will be Customer's provider of 8XX originating service in areas designated by Customer that are consistent with Qwest's CIC map, which map Qwest may change from time to time. Customer may designate itself or another carrier as the 8XX carrier in selected areas.

10. **CARRIER IDENTIFICATION CODE.**

10.1 Customer will promptly and accurately make all changes to its CIC map reasonably requested by Qwest due to changes in Qwest's CIC map.

10.2 Qwest will provide CIC mapping at the LATA level only.

10.3 No person or entity other than Customer or Qwest may act as the Resp Org or apply Qwest's CIC map to the SMS database, either acting directly or indirectly, or by assignment or agency from Customer.

11. **PRODUCT MINIMUM USAGE REQUIREMENT.** Commencing on the 1-year anniversary of the effective date of this Exhibit, if Contributory Charges during each Billing Cycle for ReQwest Services do not meet or exceed the Product Minimum stated in the Rate Exhibit, Qwest may, at Qwest's sole discretion, upon 30 calendar days e-mail notice to Customer, terminate this Exhibit without further liability or obligation to Customer.

12. **MINIMUM FACILITY UTILIZATION REQUIREMENT.** In addition to the Product Minimum, the following minimum facility utilization requirements apply to End User Dedicated 1+ Outbound Service and End User Dedicated 8XX Inbound Service:

In the event any Qwest port to which any DAL from any of Customer's End Users is connected ("Port") has 0 traffic usage for 30 consecutive days following the first 3 Billing Cycles after connection of the Port to the DAL, Qwest may, upon 30 calendar days prior e-mail notice, in its discretion, disconnect the End User DAL connected to such Port.

13. **NON-COMPLETED CALLS.** If the percentage of Customer's calls that do not complete (out of all attempted calls) meets or exceeds the Non-Completed Call Percentage Threshold for any given week, Qwest may: (a) upon 30 calendar days email notice, disconnect any and all circuit(s) providing Service on which the Non-Completed Call Percentage Threshold was exceeded; or (b) charge the Non-Completed Call Surcharge. The Non-Completed Call Percentage Threshold and the Non-Completed Call Surcharge are stated in the Rate Exhibit.

14. **TERMINATION.** Either Party may terminate this Exhibit, at its convenience, upon 60 calendar days prior written notice to the other Party.

**1. ReQwest® Switchless Reseller - OCN Billing Services - TnR SERVICE DESCRIPTION.**

1.1 Qwest will provide the ReQwest Switchless Reseller – OCN Billing Services - Transfer and Release Service ("TnR Service") pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Agreement and this Exhibit F-OCN9. Except as set forth in this Exhibit, capitalized terms shall have the definitions assigned to them in the Agreement. All references herein to Exhibit F-OCN include all associated service descriptions and rate exhibits (such as Exhibits F-OCN1 and F-OCN2).

1.2 Types of Service. To receive the TnR Service, Customer must also purchase ReQwest voice services from Qwest. The TnR Service is a Qwest toll-free routing feature that allows a Customer receiving ReQwest 8xx origination (inbound) voice service from Qwest to re-route the calling party to another destination pursuant to a pre-defined dial plan. For purposes of this Exhibit, the following defined terms are used: (a) "Calling Party" means the originator of the 8xx call; (b) "Location A" means the location to which Customer's inbound 8xx call is delivered to Customer; and (c) "Location B" means the final location to which the Calling Party's call is transferred. The TnR Service allows up to 20 transfer attempts per call, which means that Customer can have multiple terminating locations (up to 20 different Location Bs). The location at which the transferred call is answered is treated as the final Location B for that call.

There are 3 transfer types offered as part of the TnR Service: (i) Blind Transfer, (ii) Consult and Transfer, and (iii) Conference and Transfer. The transfer type used affects the length of the 8xx call billed to Customer pursuant to Exhibit F-OCN. The Qwest Transfer and Release User Guide, which is not part of this Exhibit, contains some examples.

(i) A "Blind Transfer" allows Customer to transfer the Calling Party to Location B and disconnect Location A from the call. When a Blind Transfer is used, the Calling Party is transferred directly from Location A to Location B without a consultation or conference.

(ii) A "Consult and Transfer" allows Customer to transfer the Calling Party to Location B and disconnect Location A from the call after Location B answers the call. With Consult and Transfer, Location A waits for Location B to answer the call instead of disconnecting the call upon hearing ring-back, which allows Location A to consult with Location B prior to disconnecting from the call. During the consult, the Calling Party remains on hold until the consultation between Location A and Location B is completed. Location B and the Calling Party are bridged when Location A returns to an on-hook state by hanging up the phone.

(iii) A "Conference and Transfer" also allows Customer to transfer the Calling Party to Location B and disconnect Location A from the call after Location B answers the call, with the added feature of conferencing all parties (Location A, Location B and the Calling Party) before the Calling Party is released to Location B and Location A drops from the call. After Location B answers Location A's call (a consult state), Location A can merge all parties and the Calling Party and Location B will remain connected, with Location A in control of the call, until Location A returns to an on-hook state by hanging up the phone.

1.3 Permissible Location B Destinations. A Location B that is Type 5 requires prior Qwest approval. A Location B that is Type 2, Type 4 or Type 5 requires additional documentation before the TnR Service will be provisioned. See Section 3 below.

(a) A "Type 1" Location B means that the Calling Party is transferred to a dedicated Qwest trunk group or to a direct dial number (including ANI, POTS, DID, cell phone and other direct dialable local type number, but excluding any 8xx, 900, 700 or 500 numbers) provided by Qwest to Customer.

(b) A "Type 2" Location B means that the Calling Party is transferred to a dedicated Qwest trunk group or to a direct dial number (including ANI, POTS, DID, cell phone and other direct dialable local type number, but excluding any 8xx, 900, 700 or 500 numbers) not provided by Qwest to Customer.

(c) A "Type 3" Location B means that the Calling Party is transferred to Location B via an 8xx number provided by Qwest to Customer (and the 8xx is assigned to Qwest as the Resp Org or to a Third Party Resp Org).

(d) A "Type 4" Location B means that the Calling Party is transferred to Location B via an 8xx number provided by Qwest to a party other than Customer (and the 8xx is assigned to Qwest as the Resp Org or to a Third Party Resp Org).

(e) A "Type 5" Location B means that the Calling Party is transferred to Location B via an 8xx number not provided by Qwest.

1.4 Service Limitations. The TnR Service is available for switched and dedicated terminations. The TnR Service: (a) cannot be re-sold under any circumstances; (b) is limited to a maximum of 20 transfer attempts per call; (c) is limited to 25 8xxs per order per Customer per month; (d) a maximum of 10 Type 3 and Type 4 Location Bs (total) are permitted per order per 8xx number; and (e) can not be used for Internet Protocol voice traffic. Additional limitations and requirements are contained in the order form for the TnR Service.

1.5 Service Changes. Qwest reserves the right, upon 30 calendar days prior written notice to Customer, to cancel or modify the TnR Service.

**2. TnR SERVICE RATES.**

2.1 Rates. The applicable rates, fees, terms and charges associated with the TnR Service are as set forth in this Exhibit, are in addition to the charges for the ReQwest service, and are subject to the terms of the ReQwest service (including rate changes, regulatory-related rate adjustments and backbilling). Customer will be obligated to pay all applicable usage based charges (UBCs), monthly recurring charges (MRCs), non-recurring charges (NRCs) and change fees as set forth herein.

2.2 Per Transfer UBC. The party responsible for paying the per transfer UBC is dependent on the type of Location B (see Section 1.3 above). If Location B is: (a) Type 1, Customer will be charged, and will be obligated to pay, the UBC; (b) Type 2, Customer will be charged, and will be obligated to pay, the UBC; (c) Type 3, Customer (on invoice for Location B 8xx) will be charged, and will be obligated to pay, the UBC; (d) Type 4, the owner of the Location B 8xx (the "Location B Party") will be charged, and will be obligated to pay, the UBC; and (e) Type 5, Customer will be charged, and will be obligated to pay, the UBC. Notwithstanding subsection (d) of the prior sentence, Customer will be liable for any UBCs not timely paid by the Location B Party.

When Customer is billed the UBC for Location B Types 1, 2 and 5, the UBC will appear on the invoice for the Location A 8xx. However, when Customer is billed the UBC for Location B Type 3, the UBC will appear on the invoice for the Location B 8xx regardless of whether Customer has TnR Service on the Location B 8xx.

2.3 ETFF Cap. Any caps on charges for enhanced toll free features contained in Customer's Exhibit F-OCN do NOT apply to any charges for the TnR Service.

**3. SERVICE ORDERING.**

3.1 Order Form and Dialing Plan. To receive the TnR Service, Customer must submit a completed Wholesale Toll Free Transfer and Release (TnR) Order Form and Dialing Plan through the on-line order entry system provided by Qwest (which may change from time to time). The Order Form must: (a) be submitted in conjunction with a completed Wholesale Standard Toll Free Online Order Form, also submitted via the on-line order entry system; (b) contain a representation from Customer that all fully executed TnR Acknowledgment Form(s) for each 8xx on which the TnR Service will be provisioned, if required by Section 3.2 below, have been faxed or emailed to Qwest Wholesale Contract Administration at least 24 hours prior to submission of the Order Form; and (c) contain a NSSD approval number, if required by Section 3.3 below.

**3.2 TnR Acknowledgment Form.**

(a) If Location B is Type 2, Customer agrees to execute, and to have an authorized representative of the Location B Party execute, a TnR Acknowledgment Form - A (Attachment 1), and forward the signed acknowledgment to Qwest.

(b) If Location B is Type 4 Customer agrees to execute, and to have an authorized representative of the Location B Party execute, a TnR Acknowledgment Form - B (Attachment 2), and forward the signed acknowledgment to Qwest.

(c) If Location B is Type 5 Customer agrees to execute, and to have an authorized representative of the Location B Party execute, a TnR Acknowledgment Form - A (Attachment 1), and forward the signed acknowledgment to Qwest.

(d) If any TnR Acknowledgment Form delivered to Qwest is later terminated by either Customer or an authorized representative of the Location B Party, then Customer must submit a change order to remove the TnR Service from the Location Bs covered by such terminated TnR Acknowledgment Form. Qwest may discontinue TnR Service to any Location B covered by a terminated TnR Acknowledgment Form. If Customer does not submit a change order, and Qwest continues to provide TnR Service to a Location B covered by a terminated TnR Acknowledgment Form, Customer shall be responsible for all charges related to the TnR Service, including the UBC.

**3.3 NSSD Approval.** Approval from the Qwest Non-Standard Service Delivery Team must be obtained for Location B Type 5 before an order for TnR Service may be submitted.

**3.4 Service Installation.**

(a) Customer will request a target TnR Service installation date on the submitted Order Form. Upon receipt of the submitted Order Form, Qwest will verify that all necessary information has been provided by Customer and that TnR Service is available. If Qwest determines that the submitted Order Form does not contain complete and accurate information necessary for Qwest to process the TnR Service order, Qwest will notify Customer and Customer will submit an updated Order Form.

(b) If Customer submits a valid Order Form, TnR Service is available, and the requested target installation date is within Qwest's standard provisioning intervals, then Qwest will provide Customer a delivery date upon which Qwest will install the TnR Service and make it available for testing and/or use (the "Customer Commit Due Date"). If the requested target installation date is outside Qwest's standard provisioning intervals, Customer may request an expedite. Customer and Qwest must agree to a Customer Commit Due Date and expedite charges before an expedite request will be granted.

(c) Qwest will use reasonable commercial efforts to install each ordered TnR Service on or before the Customer Commit Due Date; however, the inability of Qwest to deliver the ordered service by that date will not constitute a default giving rise to Cause under this Exhibit or the Agreement. Customer may terminate an Order Form accepted by Qwest without liability if Qwest fails to make the TnR Service available for testing by the 61<sup>st</sup> day after the Customer Commit Due Date. The right to terminate the Order Form for the delayed TnR Service is the Customer's sole and exclusive remedy for Qwest's failure to meet the Customer Commit Due Date. Qwest may change pricing and/or the Customer Commit Due Date if Customer requests changes after Qwest's acceptance of an Order Form.

**1. ReQwest® OCN Switchless Reseller -VIRTUAL CARRIER SERVICE DESCRIPTION.**

1.1 Qwest will provide the ReQwest OCN Switchless Reseller - Virtual Carrier Service (the "ReQwest VCS") pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Agreement and this Exhibit F-OCN12. Except as set forth in this Exhibit, capitalized terms shall have the definitions assigned to them in the Agreement.

1.2 The ReQwest VCS is a network routing service whereby Customer's Carrier Identification Code ("CIC") is loaded in each Customer-designated Local Exchange Carrier ("LEC") tandem(s)/ end office(s), so that all usage associated with Customer's CIC is routed by such tandem(s)/ end office(s) to the Qwest network. The ReQwest VCS includes all procedures for (a) ordering, provisioning and testing the CIC load into the LEC tandem(s)/ end office(s) and (b) loading End User ANIs into Qwest's on-line order entry system.

1.3 To receive the ReQwest VCS, (a) Customer must also purchase ReQwest voice services from Qwest and (b) Customer must have a CIC.

1.4 The ReQwest VCS is available only where Qwest has Feature Group D originating facilities and where the applicable LEC offers the features that are necessary for sub-CIC access services. Qwest has no obligation to add to or change any of its facilities to provide the ReQwest VCS to Customer.

1.5 Qwest reserves the right to refuse to accept, suspend or limit any or all of Customer's traffic that Qwest believes is adversely affecting other customers or the Qwest network.

**2. ReQWEST VCS RATES.**

2.1 After receiving Customer's completed sub-CIC workbook, Qwest will provide Customer an estimated cost for the installation of Customer's CIC to Customer-designated LEC tandem(s)/ end office(s) ("Estimated Install Fee"). The Estimated Install Fee will include an estimate of all LEC access services request ("ASR") charges, a Qwest administrative fee in the amount set forth in the Ancillary Services section of the Rate Exhibit ("Qwest Administrative Fee"), and any other charges that may apply. Prior to the commencement of installation, Customer must pay to Qwest at least 50% of the Estimated Install Fee ("Deposit"). In the event that Customer requests that its CIC be provisioned to additional LEC tandem(s)/ end office(s), Qwest will calculate a new Estimated Install Fee, and Customer must pay an additional Deposit prior to such provisioning.

2.2 Upon completion of CIC loading and testing, Qwest will determine the actual installation fee due by Customer to Qwest ("Actual Install Fee"). Customer must pay Qwest, according to the general payment terms of the Agreement, the balance of the Actual Install Fee after reducing it by the applicable Deposit(s).

2.3 The rates and charges in this Section 2 are in addition to the charges for the ReQwest service and are subject to the terms of the ReQwest service (including rate changes, regulatory-related rate adjustments and backbilling).

**3. LEC PROVISIONING TERMS.**

3.1 Customer must complete the Qwest sub-CIC workbook, indicating which LEC tandem(s)/ end office(s) should load Customer's CIC as a sub-CIC associated with the Qwest network. Customer's CIC will be loaded through the installation and completion of ASRs at each LEC tandem/ end-office, as determined by the LEC and as documented by Customer in a form satisfactory to Qwest.

3.2 Upon receipt of a complete list of designated LEC tandems/ end offices and all other requested documentation (e.g., letters of authorization), Qwest will provide an estimated service commencement date ("Commencement Date") for the ReQwest VCS. Qwest will use commercially reasonable efforts to meet any Commencement Date, but Qwest shall have no liability to Customer or any End User for any failure to meet such Commencement Date.

3.3 If Customer makes an error in designating LEC tandem(s) or end office(s), or otherwise modifies any information it provides to Qwest in the sub-CIC workbook, Customer is responsible for paying all

charges associated with such error or modification, including without limitation, LEC change order fees, ASR cancellation fees, and the LEC SUP Charge and Qwest SUP Charge set forth in the Ancillary Services section of the Rate Exhibit. In no event will Qwest be liable for any associated LEC charges.

**4. CARE PROVISIONING TERMS.**

4.1 Customer must process all Customer Account Record Exchange ("CARE") transactions for Customer's CIC. Customer must submit orders for all ANIs to Qwest within 48 hours of receipt of a written Primary Interexchange Carrier ("PIC") order from the LEC.

4.2 Customer is solely responsible for dealing directly with the LEC regarding all CARE services, and Qwest is not responsible or liable in any way for any CARE services or acts or omissions of LECs, including without limitation, those related to PIC changes.

4.3 Customer is solely responsible for selecting the "No PIC" option for each ANI entered into Qwest's on-line order entry system.

**5. OTHER SERVICE TERMS.**

5.1 Customer must enter each End User ANI in the on-line order entry system provided by Qwest (which may change from time to time) at least 1 business day prior to the final scheduled delivery date of the ReQwest VCS. Customer may be required to execute other agreements, including without limitation, software license agreements, related to the use of Qwest's on-line order entry system. When entering ANIs into Qwest's on-line order entry system, Customer is responsible for assigning each End User ANI to the appropriate Qwest product account. Customer is also responsible for promptly removing each End User ANI from its Qwest product account whenever appropriate, including without limitation, when the End User changes its PIC. Customer waives any and all claims against Qwest arising out of Customer's failure to timely update the appropriate Qwest product account(s), which updates include, without limitation, entering and assigning each End User ANI or removing each End User ANI due to an End User PIC change.

5.2 Qwest bills for calls routed to the Qwest network via the ReQwest VCS on an ANI basis. Thus all ANIs presubscribed to Customer's CIC and, therefore, riding Qwest's facilities, must be loaded into Qwest's on-line order entry system in the manner specified by Qwest (a) at least 1 day prior to initial sub-CIC load (the scheduled delivery date) and (b) at least 48 hours subsequent to any ongoing PIC change. Failure to do so will result in Qwest billing Customer ongoing charges associated with such ANI, and directly billing affected End Users at casual calling rates.

**6. TERMINATION.**

6.1 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Agreement, the ReQwest VCS will not be available, and Qwest may terminate this Exhibit, if the applicable LEC(s) terminates the provision of any service necessary for Qwest to provide the ReQwest VCS. Qwest is not responsible for any termination fees or liabilities of any kind resulting from any such unavailability or termination of the ReQwest VCS.

6.2 Without affecting any other Customer obligations herein, upon 30 calendar days prior written notice by Customer to Qwest, Customer may cancel, disconnect, or terminate sub-CIC routing to any tandem(s)/ end office(s), provided that such notice specifically identifies the affected LEC tandem(s)/ end office(s).

6.3 Either Party may terminate this Exhibit, at its convenience, upon 60 calendar days prior written notice to the other Party.
