Third Quarter 2022 Revisions to Exhibit 3: Program Details**

Dear Ms. Maxwell,

Consistent with requirements outlined in WAC 408-109-120(3)(c) and WAC 480-07-140(5) Puget Sound Energy (“PSE”) provides an electronic version of its third quarter 2022 *Exhibit 3: Program Details* updates and revisions. This twenty-third version replaces version twenty-two. The update represents changes to customer incentives and streamlining of available offerings.

Highlights of key revisions include:

- PSE is increasing the incentive amount on numerous measures to better influence the market.
- PSE is adapting programs to incorporate partner information that wasn’t available at the time of the filing of the BCP.
- Some measures that have experienced low throughput have been removed.
- The Virtual Commissioning Pilot was converted from a pilot to a full program.

Consistent with WAC 480-109-110(3), PSE provided an electronic version of the mark-up version of Exhibit 3 to its Conservation Resource Advisory Group (“CRAG”) on July 14, 2022.
