3	WAC 480-07-380(3)(b) states that the Commission will "grant such a motion when

4	The representatives of the other parties to this case, Beeline Tours LTD d/b/a Seattle
	Express, and Pacific Northwest Transportation Services, Inc. d/b/a Premier Airport
	Shuttle/Capital Aeroporter, have substantial experience appearing before the Commission,
	and therefore have the resources to fully develop the facts necessary for the Commission to
	decide this matter.

The conditions outlined above support granting Staff's motion to withdraw as in the

public interest.
