In the Matter of the Investigation of HEEZY HAULERS LLC, For Compliance with WAC 480-15-560 and WAC 480-15-555.	DOCKETS TV-250185 and TV-260055 ORDER 03/02 GRANTING PAYMENT ARRANGEMENT
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BACKGROUND

- 1 On March 16, 2026, the Commission issued Order 02 in Docket TV-250185, which imposed a \$2,000 suspended penalty against Heezy Haulers LLC (Heezy Haulers or Company) due to repeat safety violations.
- 2 On March 23, 2026, the Commission issued Order 01 in Docket TV-260055, which assessed penalty of \$2,500 for safety violations discovered during a safety investigation. Order 01 required the Company to pay the \$2,500 penalty within 30 days of issuance of Order 01.
- 3 On May 1, 2026, Commission staff (Staff) filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that the Company reached out to Staff and requested to establish a single monthly payment arrangement to cover the combined \$4,500 in assessed penalties, and that Staff supports the request. Staff and Heezy Haulers' agreed upon the following payment plan:

4 According to Staff, the Company is aware that if it fails to pay any installment by the due date, the entire remaining balance will become immediately due and payable without further Commission order.

DISCUSSION

5 The installment payment schedule proposed by Staff and the Company is reasonable. Accordingly, the Commission approves the proposal with one modification. The Company may make additional payments in advance of the payment due dates or pay an increased amount on the due dates, but no additional payment or increased amount will relieve the Company of its obligation to make its timely monthly installment until the full amount of \$4,500 is satisfied.

ORDER

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 6 (1) The \$4,500 combined penalty is due and payable to the Commission in installments as set out in paragraph 3.
- 7 (2) If Heezy Haulers LLC fails to pay any installment by 5 p.m. on the date it is due, the unpaid balance will immediately become due and payable without further order by the Commission.

8 The Secretary has been delegated authority to enter this order on behalf of the Commissioners under WAC 480-07-904(1)(h).
