- (f) Relocation of Services and Facilities: If relocation of service or distribution facilities on or adjacent to the customer's premises, including Company-owned transformers, is for the convenience of the applicant or the customer, such relocation will be performed by Company provided the applicant or the customer pays in advance, a nonrefundable sum equal to the estimated installed cost of the relocated facilities, including operating expense, plus estimated removal cost, less estimated salvage and less depreciation of the facilities to be removed.
- (g) Liability: Company's liability shall cease at the point of delivery and the use of electric service beyond said point is at the risk and responsibility of the customer.
- (h) Maintenance of Customer's Facilities: Customers are responsible for maintaining their own facilities. If a Customer requests a service call, and the problem is in the Customer's facilities, the Company may charge for the service call as specified in Schedule 300.
