Please provide the therm savings from Avista-sponsored DSM programs in Washington State in total, and by customer class and/or rate schedule, for each year 2000, 2001, 2002, and 2003.

RESPONSE:

The Company did not track individual project savings by state and rate class/schedule until 2004. Historically, we've seen about 70% of our savings attributable to Washington. The following numbers come from our Triple-E reports for 2001-2003, with the 70% allocation applied, to get to Washington's share of natural gas savings acquired through Avista-sponsored DSM programs.

The Company did not have natural gas DSM programs in effect during 2000. All Residential and Limited Income customers would be residential revenue class. Non-residential consists of customers in the commercial and industrial revenue class. The majority of the savings shown generally are attributable to commercial revenue class.
