	complexity of the bid, the final award to Wilson Construction and the associated Notice to Proceed (NTP) were delayed until 8/19/21. The construction started in early September and due to a number of factors (<i>e.g.</i> , outside engineering and agency staff resource limitations, outage restrictions, and material constraints), the amount of work completed was less than anticipated. The majority of the planned 2021 construction work and associated budget was pushed out to 2022.
