

Verizon Northwest respectfully requests this ICB contract become effective June 29, 2008. Amendment No. 1 extends the term of the current agreement for 36 months. If the amendment is not effective upon the expiration of the current term, which is June 29, 2008, the company will have to revert the customer's DS1 Special Access Line Service to higher rates under the tariff. Customer executed the renewal agreement on 6/11/08. LRN is required to have renewal agreement made effective prior to expiration of current agreement. Customer is currently receiving this service under Contract No. 1299ICB, effective 4/30/05 in Docket No. UT-050454.
