

Dear Judge Moss:

At the hearing on June 9, 2009, Mr. Bryan of San Juan Express, Inc. was asked by staff or the Bench what the annual ridership on the route was in 2008 for which the Company is seeking a temporary discontinuance. Although we do not have a copy of the transcript, we now believe he provided an incorrect estimate based on confusion over one-way trips/trip segments and the total number of people using the service. For the 2008 season, the total number of ticketed passengers as reported is approximately 17,212 and the total number of one-way trips is 34,424 as he indicated to the staff in May. We apologize for any confusion this may have caused during his testimony.
