- 2 On September 24, 2008, Staff of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission filed a letter and on September 25, 2009, Sanitary Service Company, Inc., and Blaine Bay Refuse, Inc. filed a letter with the Commission waiving their right to seek administrative review of Order 01 and requesting the Commission allow the order to become final by operation of law as soon as practicable.
