
Dear Pierce County and UTC Officials:

In follow-up to my January 6, 2011 letter to David W. Danner of the WUTC, I am writing on behalf of my client Meeker Southern Railroad ("Meeker") to forward flagging cards for four certified flaggers from Asphalt Patch Systems, Inc. who will (or may) be involved in the temporary flagging of the 134th Avenue East Crossing: (1) Sharon K. Ward (who holds a Washington State Traffic Control Supervisor's card, which I understand is actually a higher level certification than evidenced by the Washington State Traffic Control Flagger's card), (2) Jim L. Rose, (3) Craig Allen Smith, and (4) Gordon W. Vail IV. Photocopies of their respective cards accompany this letter.
