TO ALL PARTIES:

On November 7, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) issued a Complaint for Penalties and Notice of Brief Adjudicative Proceeding; Setting Time for Oral Statements on December 10, 2019, at 9 a.m. (Complaint) against Chris Robert Miller, d/b/a Silver Limousine and Silver Transportation, (Silver Limousine or Company) for alleged violations of Title 81 RCW. The brief adjudicative proceeding was later rescheduled to March 3, 2020.

On February 28, 2020, Staff contacted the presiding officer to inform the Commission that Staff and the Company have reached a settlement in principle. That same day, the Commission issued a Notice canceling the brief adjudicative proceeding and requiring the parties to file a settlement agreement or report on the status of negotiations by March 17, 2020.

On March 17, 2020, Staff contacted the presiding officer and requested additional time to finalize the settlement agreement. Staff explained that, due to competing work priorities, the parties were unable to meet the March 17 deadline.

The Commission supports the parties' efforts to resolve this matter by agreement, and therefore finds good cause to extend the deadline for filing settlement documents.
