2. WAC 480-123-130(1)(b) - Use of Support for Telecommunications Services

The funds received by the Company from the universal communications services program in calendar year 2021 contributed to defrayal of the ongoing operation and maintenance expenses of the Company. These funds are also contributing to the Company's ongoing provision of high-quality basic telecommunications services and the expansion of faster broadband service available to customers residing in the area the Company serves.

In December 2021, the Company received \$173,032 from the universal communications services program for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2022.

During the first six months of 2022 the Company worked on major projects as follows: 1) FTTH Riverside apartments Phase 1 \$24,000; 2) FTTH Riverside Estates \$39,000; 3) Kays Subdivision \$16,000; 4) FTTH Highland Terrace Phase 2 \$40,000; 5) other routine drops \$163,000, and line extensions and other capacity improvements \$153,000. The Company also has \$80,000 of projects open for vectoring and bonding that will increase broadband speeds. In addition, the Company has budgeted \$36,000 for A-CAM improvements for 2022. The funds received from the universal communications services program can be

viewed as contributing to the Company's ability to perform these projects plus cover normal operating expenses. The Company opens all major projects that are budgeted early in the year thus those described above will continue throughout 2022 in addition to routine maintenance, cable additions and other projects that will be done as needed. Details for 2021 expenditures are included in Report 1 of the annual ETC filing submitted on or around July 1.

3. WAC 480-123-130(1)(c) – Use of Support for Broadband Services

The investments described improve the multi-use network for both voice and broadband services. See also Attachment 1 for non-ACAM specific location data for locations that were upgraded to 25/3 or faster during 2021. Prior to 2021 these locations either had a speed less than 25/3 or were not able to get TDS broadband service). FCC Speed Tier Decoder:

The funds received from the universal communications services program can be viewed as assisting in the Company's efforts to obtain operational efficiencies.
