On November 1, 2023, Avista Corporation d/b/a Avista Utilities (Avista), PacifiCorp d/b/a Pacific Power & Light Company (PacifiCorp), and Puget Sound Energy (PSE) filed their tenyear achievable electric conservation potential for the period 2024-2034 and electric Biennial Conservation Plans (BCPs)¹ for the period 2024-2025.
