MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE
SUPPLEMENTAL EXHIBIT OF
PUBLIC COUNSEL

1. Pursuant to WAC 480-07-375 and 480-07-510, the Public Counsel Section of the Washington Attorney General's Office (Public Counsel) hereby moves the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) for leave to file a supplemental exhibit, labeled Exhibit No. BCO-8. Pursuant to the schedule in Prehearing Conference Order 04, Public Counsel filed testimony of Mr. Bion Ostrander addressing revenue requirement that is supported by various exhibits, including Exhibit No. BCO-3C. PacifiCorp informed Public Counsel of its contention that Exhibit No. BCO-3C does not provide sufficient detailed information and does not fully comply with the Prehearing Conference Order 04, paragraphs 9-11, regarding the format for presenting revenue requirement testimony. To avoid controversy, and to allow full review of its proposals, Public Counsel has agreed to file a supplemental exhibit, which has been pre-marked as Exhibit No. BCO-8. This exhibit supplements but does not replace Mr. Ostrander's other exhibits. PacifiCorp's legal counsel has reviewed Exhibit No. BCO-8 and believes that it complies with the requirements of the prehearing conference order. Therefore, PacifiCorp has authorized Public Counsel to state that it does not object to this Motion.

2. Accordingly, Public Counsel respectfully requests that the Commission grant it leave to file Exhibit No. BCO-8.
