TO ALL PARTIES:

On April 29, 2019, the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) entered Final Order 02, Affirming Order 01, in Part; Granting Request for Review, in Part (Order 02) in this docket. Order 02 imposed a \$3,600 penalty against White Pass Community Service Coalition, d/b/a Lewis Mountain Highway Transit, (White Pass or Company), \$3,200 of which was suspended for two years, to be waived thereafter, subject to the conditions that: a) White Pass not incur any repeat critical violations upon reinspection within two years; and b) the Company pay the \$400 portion of the penalty that was not suspended.

On April 29, 2021, Staff filed a letter in this docket informing the Commission that the Company had timely paid the \$400 portion of the penalty that was not suspended and that the Company received a satisfactory rating without incurring any repeat violations of critical regulations upon reinspection.

The Commission finds that White Pass has complied with the conditions of Order 02. The \$3,200 portion of the penalty that was suspended is now waived, and this docket is closed.
