MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE

REQUEST FOR EXEMPTION

1 On February 28, 2024, the presiding officer in this proceeding issued Order 01
disapproving the proposed safety management plan and cancelling provisional authority for
permit THG-068754. Pursuant to WAC 480-07-825(3) and WAC 480-07-385(2)(a), Staff gives
notice to the presiding officer and parties that it intends to file a motion for clarification of initial
order and requests a continuance to facilitate proper drafting of that motion.

2 Staff also requests an exemption under WAC 480-07-110 from the normal five-day
requirement of WAC 480-07-385(3)(a).

I. MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE

3 Staff intends to file a motion for clarification on a number of issues within Order 01.
Given the number of issues raised, Staff does not feel that it will be able to serve this motion
within the five days designated by WAC 480-07-825(3) for a motion for clarification of an initial
order. Staff therefore requests that the presiding officer extend the deadline for filing this motion
by 10 business days, or in the alternative, a length of time that the presiding officer finds
appropriate for this motion.

II. REQUEST FOR EXEMPTION

4 Under WAC 480-07-825(3)(a), a party has five days to serve a motion for clarification after the issuance of an initial order. Under WAC 480-07-385(3), a party must serve a motion for continuance at least five days prior to the deadline the party wishes to continue. Given the timelines present within these two provisions, it is all but impossible for Staff to serve a motion for continuance on a motion for clarification of an initial order. Therefore, Staff requests an exemption from this provision pursuant to WAC 480-07-110.
