- I, Betty Young, under penalty of perjury under the laws of the state of Washington, declare as follows:
- I am over 18 years of age, a citizen of the United States, a resident of the state of Washington, and competent to be a witness.
- I am employed by the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) as the Rail Operations Manager. I have been employed at the Commission since 1999, and have worked in the Rail Safety Program since 2015.
- I am familiar with the Barker Road crossing (USDOT 662526C) and the modifications proposed by the City of Spokane Valley (City).
- I have spoken with staff at the Washington Department of Transportation (WSDOT) about this project. WSDOT administers several federal aid funds for the Federal Highway Administration, including the Section 130 fund, the Surface Transportation Block Grant Program (STBG), and the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP). WSDOT staff confirmed the Barker Road project is funded with both STBG funds and HSIP funds.
- 6 Commission staff redesigned its railroad crossing petition forms in March 2021 to include sections for petitioners to provide additional information such as a description of the public safety need for the project, as well as cost apportionment and maintenance fees. I provided a copy of this new form to the City in March 2021.
