**MOTION TO AMEND SCHEDULING
ORDER**

1. Respondent T-Netix, Inc. ("T-Netix"), by its attorneys, hereby moves to amend the procedural schedule attached as Appendix A to Order No. 9 because the marriage this week of counsel for T-Netix will interfere with providing timely responses to data requests and with the negotiations regarding objections to data requests as required in paragraph 62 of Order No. 9. *See Declaration of Glenn R. Manishin in Support of Motion to Amend Scheduling Order. All parties have consented to the time extensions requested by T-Netix.*

2. Responses to written discovery are due on October 29, 2008. Glenn Manishin's wedding date is this Saturday, October 25, 2008, and he will be on his honeymoon until Monday, November 3, 2008. Mr. Manishin will be in and out of the office this week in order to accomplish last-minute wedding preparations. He was also out of the office for a business meeting from Friday October 17 through Sunday October 19.

3. On Wednesday, October 15, 2008, T-Netix received a set of 23 data requests from AT&T and a set of 25 data requests from Complainants. Providing the documents responsive to all of these data requests would take thousands of man hours and tens of thousands of dollars. T-Netix expects to raise numerous objections to the scope of the data requests, particularly those propounded by complainants. T-Netix will work diligently with counsel for Complainants to work out as many objections as possible before responding to the data requests.

4. Responding to the data requests will require extensive efforts by Mr. Manishin who has been T-Netix's counsel since this matter began over eight years ago. There is simply not enough time to appropriately negotiate over objections and prepare responses.

5. The parties have agreed to the following amended procedural schedule, which reflects a two-week extension of all dates.

Responses to Written Discovery (all parties)	November 12, 2008
Motions to Compel (all parties)	November 19, 2008
Proposed Witness Lists (all parties)	December 17, 2008
Depositions Completed (all parties)	January 28, 2009
Responses to Both Motions	February 11, 2009

6. T-Netix seeks only as much time as is necessary to avoid undue prejudice to T-Netix. This brief two-week extension will not conflict with the Commission's prompt adjudication of this matter, the preparation of any party, or the interests of justice..
