To the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission:

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on Puget Sound Energy's plans for power generation in our state.

I live on Vashon Island, with solar panels on my house that provide about 50% of my electricity throughout the course of a year. I am a PSE rate payer for the rest of my power, which gives me great incentive to ask that PSE start planning now for a smooth transition away from coal by 2025.

Please shorten the payment schedule for Units 3 and 4 at Colstrip so that these units are paid for by 2025. King County's **Strategic Climate Action Plan** stresses the phase-out of coal-fired electricity sources by 2025. And 2025 is the date of the first round of compliance with the Paris Climate Agreement. I hope PSE can take a leadership role in compliance with the **Strategic Climate Action Plan** and in advancing clean and green energy for the planet we inhabit.
