In accordance with section 4.4 of Yakama Indian Nation Resolution T-177-02, Pacific Power signed a temporary franchise ordinance with the Nation in December, 2002. Pursuant to the ordinance and the approval of the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission, Pacific Power pays a three percent (3%) franchise fee to the Nation. A separate line item was added to all customer accounts on the reservation and is currently identified as "Yakama Nation Franchise Fee."
