1 On May 11, 2004, the Commission entered Order No. 01 in Docket No. UE-031946, Order Granting Application; Approving Agreement Regarding SQI-11 Amendment with Modifications.

2 On May 21, 2004, Puget Sound Energy, Inc. (PSE) filed with the Commission substitute revised pages 14-18 of Appendix 2 of Exhibit J to the Settlement Stipulation approved in the Twelfth Supplemental order in Docket Nos. UE-011570 and UG-011571. PSE also filed Attachments A and B to an Agreement Regarding Amendment to Service Quality Index Reporting Methodology; SQI-11: Electric Safety Response Time, which agreement the Commission approved in Order No. 01 in this docket.

3 The Commission finds that the revised pages to Appendix 2 of Exhibit J and Attachments A and B to the SQI-11 Agreement filed with the Commission on May 21, 2004, comply with the Commission’s Order No. 01 in Docket No. UE-031946 and that the revised service quality standards should be approved and become effective immediately.

4 No party filed comments in response to the filing.

- 5 THE COMMISSION ORDERS That the revised pages to Appendix 2 of Exhibit J to the Settlement Stipulation approved in the Twelfth Supplemental order in Docket Nos. UE-011570 and UG-011571 and Attachments A and B to the SQI-11 Agreement as filed with the Commission on May 21, 2004, are in accordance with Order No. 01 in this proceeding and shall become effective immediately.
- 6 THE COMMISSION FURTHER ORDERS That jurisdiction is retained by the Commission to effectuate the provisions of this and prior Orders entered in this proceeding.
